After a good start to the month I became distracted by the festive season and more programming and so additions have been slight.

Added boxes 224 to 233

Added another nine exhibits to bring the total to 3912 including a Siemens Type A from 1917.

Added Klystrons and Microwave Triodes book .PDF as article 187.

Stig Comstedt pointed out that the WL-417A reflex klystron was not used in the SCR-287 Aircraft Radio as my source in 2001 had stated. I have now found a .PDF data-sheet and updated the entry. I cannot find what it was actually used in, but a radar receiver is certain.

At the end of 2014 the museum has 3912 exhibits – 499 more than a year ago, 231 articles with an additional 141 small technical features, 234 boxes, 22 films and 2190 .PDF files. The high resolution pictures number 9,509 and there are 10,554 Types listed in the equivalents section.
