The typography for the articles type pages has been refined. The presence of superior and inferior characters has in the past distorted the line spacing (leading), this has been eliminated. HTML now supports the thin space, this should be used between values and units. The thin space should be non-breaking but does not have that property at present. 100 Hz with the value on one line and the unit turned over is a typographic crime.

In the process 18 years of article preparation some discrepancies of style have emerged and these are slowly being eliminated. This work is part of the process of making the museum easier for someone else to maintain as I cannot guarantee I will live for ever.
