Boxes and adverts can be found in the same way, by search or via the indexes.

Related links appear in the main heading box, under the title plus the extra's menu on the right side of each page is being expanded to give links to related material.

Last month we published a major new PDF work by Keith Thrower, details of 6,500 British valves from 1915 to 1960.

This month the information from Keith has been divided into sections by make/brand in the Adverts and Boxes section of the museum. The conversion to text file and subsequent encoding for HTML followed by the insertion of more than 2,500 links to museum exhibits has taken all month.

Within the extras menu on the right-hand side is a link to the valve data. The base connection data sits in the file containing the basic details of the base such as B4, IO etc.
